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Public Statement

The recently reported incident in the premises of Law Centre–II, Faculty of Law, University of Delhi, wherein Prof. Anupam Jha, an erudite scholar, and a professor of repute, was assaulted by a Ph.D. scholar, has caused deep concern and grave anguish amongst the academia. The act of indiscipline by a law scholar against a reputed professor of long standing is highly deplorable and warrants unequivocal condemnation by the academic community and the well-meaning members of the society at large. Such an unruly behaviour is wholly unacceptable.

The Confederation of Law Teachers, India (COLATE), condemns the incident and calls upon the University authorities to act decisively and uphold the dignity of every teacher.
